USE CONNECTIVES AT THE START OF SENTENCES, NOT IN THE MIDDLE

BE CAREFUL - THEY ALL HAVE SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT MEANINGS

## CORRECT

This is a **short** list of connectives. There are many more out there waiting to join in:

<u>ADDING TO A POINT</u>	<u>CHANGING DIRECTION</u>	<u>HAMMERING HOME</u>
Similarly, Furthermore, Moreover, In addition, Additionally, Firstly, ... secondly, etc.	However, In contrast, By contrast, On the other hand, Nevertheless,	Thus, Therefore, Hence, Consequently, Accordingly, As a result,

Use **adverbs** to add colour:

Interestingly, Strangely, Significantly,	Unexpectedly, Disappointingly, Surprisingly,

## ADVANCED

The word 'however' creates more grammar errors than any other word. It's safest to use it at the start of a sentence followed by a comma. Never use 'however' to join two sentences together.
